Blue Class Science – Blue Class enjoyed creating light sources using clay. They learnt that these can be both hot and cold. Blue also learnt about bioluminescence.

Did you know that bacteria, mushrooms, jellyfish, worms and even sharks and scorpions glow in the dark like a glow stick?



UV Science – UV enjoyed working practically to demonstrate that light travels in straight lines from a light source. They also modelled how we see things with light reflecting off an object and then into our eyes - well done!




Indigo Class Science – Indigo Class enjoyed identifying a variety of different solids, liquids and gases. Did you know that not all solids are hard, such as playdough and a sponge? Some solids can even be poured, such as rice, sand and flour! Indigo also explored how liquids behave by pouring them and we also looked at viscosity. Finally, we discussed examples of gases and their properties as well as identifying which materials could be more than one state. For example, a balloon is made up of a solid, liquid and a gas!

Our new topic in Red Class is 'All Around the World' This week we have had stories from Finland (*Moomin*), Kenya (*Handa's Surprise*) and Japan (*Suki's Kimono*). We did line drawings of Moomin, fruit prints and a gorgeous collage of Suki in her kimono, using special Japanese paper.
