Remembrance Day and Poppies

On Monday UV will be leading a Remembrance Assembly for the Juniors. UV parents are welcome to come.

For many years Yellow Class have traditionally composed a 'Field of Poppies' picture for Remembrance using different paint techniques including brushwork and printing. This year they have gone one step further and created their masterpieces on canvas. Well done Yellow Class.





Orange Class had a lovely discussion all about poppies and why we wear them in November. We talked about symbols of peace, and the children remembered the story of Noah's Ark and the dove of peace.

We also watched a CBeebies clip that is beautifully pitched for young children. I've attached the link below in case you'd like to take a look and perhaps continue the conversation at home - if the children mention it (or even if they don't!), it's a lovely watch.

We touched on the topic of war, using language like "baddies" and "goodies." The baddies were unkind and wanted to take over our country. They aimed to change who we were and stop us from making our own decisions, so we had to stand up to them. Sadly, some people lost their lives, both goodies and baddies, and the poppy helps us remember them all.

The children used coffee filter paper for the petals, adding colour with either paint or food colouring, using brushes or pipettes. They worked beautifully while listening to some Elgar - very WW2! Their beautiful poppies made a delightful display in Orange Class.

UV enjoyed researching constellations and creating artwork - well done!

A constellation is a group of stars that make a recognisable shape or pattern. Each shape might resemble an animal, object or person and each one has its own special name. Many of them are named after mythological figures.

Did you know? There are currently 88 official constellations. The 13 zodiac signs used in astrology are also constellations, such as Virgo, Aries and Sagittarius.
